Method: Theory will be delivered electronically and knowledge assessed using an online quiz and practical session.

Each member of staff will receive their own personal log in details and password, our online learning is being hosted on www.osgolearning.co.uk where learners will be directed through the modules to complete in their own time.

There are four sections to be completed:

Section 1 – Responsive casualty with an obstructed airway

Section 2 – Unresponsive casualty who is breathing normally

Section 3 - Unresponsive casualty who is not breathing normally

Section 4 - Anaphylaxis

Additional section – COVID 19 Guidelines

Key points:

- ♥ Study method - Online, self-paced (1- 2 study hours)
- ♥ Course format - Online (24/7 access), modular
- ♥ Course Duration - Part-time (1 year access)
- ♥ Assessment - 15 questions
- ♥ Qualification - Certificate of completion
- ♥ Course Delivery – via desktop PC/MAC, laptops, tablets or smart phones

Upon completion of the theory modules and online quiz we will arrange a visit to assess the practical elements of first aid which include:

- ♥ CPR on a baby/child and adult
- ♥ Demonstration of the safe use of an AED
- ♥ the procedure for assisting a choking casualty on a manikin
- ♥ the use of an adrenaline (training) auto-injector

Practical assessments will be delivered in small groups (depending on room size but no more than 4 people) and run at 20 minute intervals (see example below).
